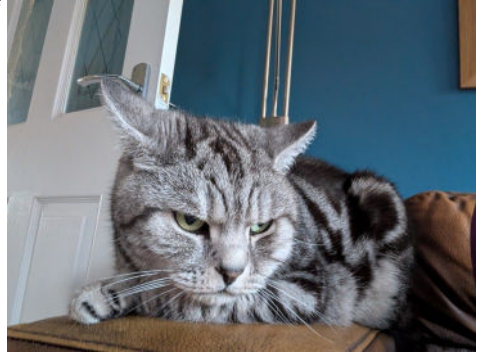
INTERVIEW WITH STACEY MCSHANE- BY IG

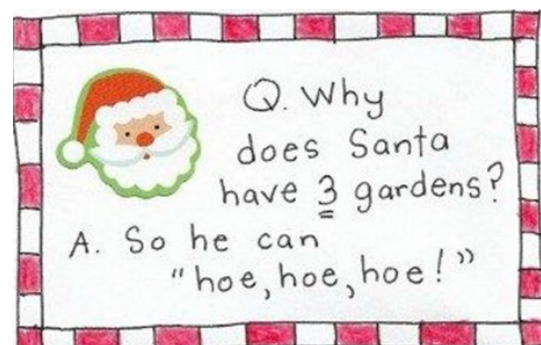
Love or Hate

Will happiness be something they find.



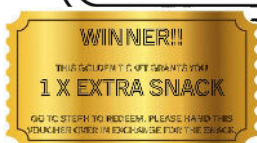
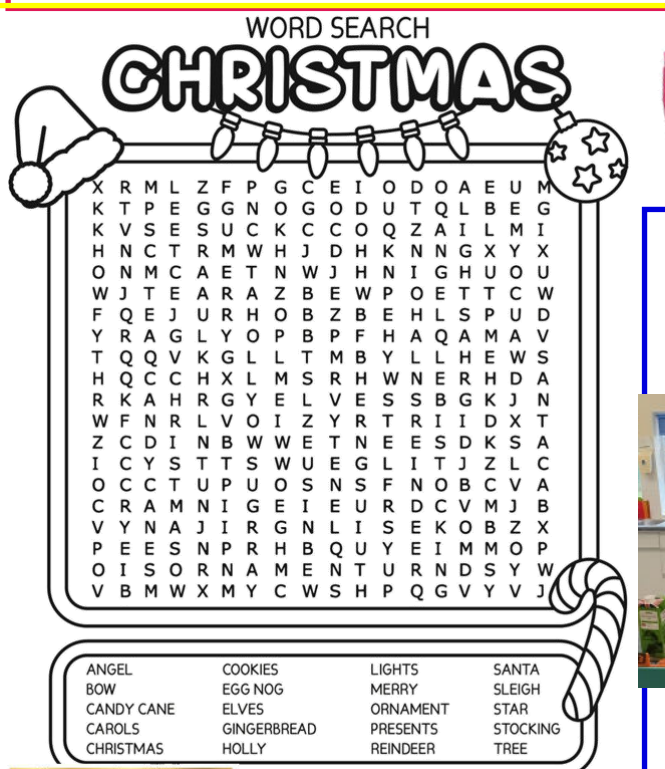
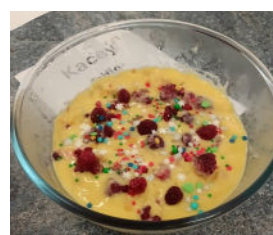
