In **Mathematics** this term.

In **English**.

We are working on three letter high frequency words being able to read and spell them using phonic. I will also be working with Jack to help him read more confidently and with expression.



In **Science**. This term we will study plants and the function of their different parts. We will also be looking at healthy lifestyles.

In **ICT** We will look at using word or PowerPoint to produce a poster or leaflet based on their interests that will give information.

How to help at home Use ICT to make a colourful poster about yourself and your interests.



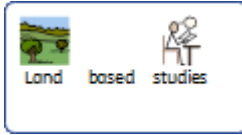
In **Construction** next term, We are going to be working in line with the creative curriculum next term which is Crime and punishment, and will base the workshop's projects around the classroom learning.
