Ahead of the new term, I thought it a good time to write to you as Magpie's Form Tutor to let you know about what we are doing this term for each of the subjects.

In English, Magpies will be studying a unit of work on Detective fiction. They will be reading fiction based on detectives including Sherlock Holmes as well as creating their own fictional character.

In Mathematics, Magpies will be looking at how to work out missing angles, translating shapes and Co-ordinates in all 4 quadrants.

In Science, Magpies will be completing a unit of work around Light and how light is reflected.

In the creative curriculum, Magpies will be studying a unit of work on Crime and Punishment looking at how punishments for Crimes have changed throughout the ages.

In PE, Magpies will be taking part in squash sessions at the local sports hall (Stour Centre).

In Food Technology, Magpies will be looking at foods from around the world giving pupils the opportunities to try new food and cook a range of different dishes from different continents.

In Art/DT, Magpies will be working alongside the Creative Curriculum within the topic of Crime and Punishment as well as creating a model for the latest Independent Learning Project.

There will also be further opportunities for off- site learning with weekly planned educational trips that you will be informed about separately.

Some pupils may also have specific parts of their curriculum planned individually.
